School Partnerships for Clinical Placements	The OSU College of Education offers initial licensure programs at both the undergraduate and graduate levels and based at three campuses (Corvallis, Cascades and Ecampus Hybrid sites). Each of these offerings includes extended classroom immersion experiences ranging from 15 weeks to two years. We offer placements across the state and have agreements with virtually every district in Oregon, including dual language and immersion schools in metro and rural areas.

- A Dual Language Specialization offered to both pre and in-service teachers. Can be combined with ESOL or standalone.
- A demonstrated commitment to bilingual education, including partnerships with dual language bilingual schools, faculty with expertise in dual language bilingual education.
- Extensive study abroad opportunities and international internships programs for Education major and primary major options including a partnership in Macau, China.
